Items proposed, seconded and agreed were as follows: -

The Accounts for 2022-2023 were approved.

David Hill and Alan Reed were re-elected. Mike Bryant was formally appointed in accordance with Nomination 1.

Spectrum (Freedom-Leisure) have advised that the lineage will be increased for next season from £12.00 to £12.50. It was agreed that the league fees should remain at £15.00 per player, in accordance with Proposal No. 1.

All the prizes for the previous season had been paid by bank transfer.

With 14 teams, the League to run three times round, starting 6 September 2023 and finishing on 17 July 2024, with no scheduled bowling on 20 and 27 December 2023 for the Christmas holidays. There will be no scheduled bowling on 25 October 2023 and 14 February 2024 for Half-terms, 3 and 10 April 2024 for the Easter holidays and 29 May 2024 for Half-term.

This means that the next AGM can be held on 28 August 2024 allowing the following season to start on 11 September 2024.

There were two proposals for changes to the Constitution for consideration: -

- 1. To change the Prize List to remove Prizes for Points and to retain the Refund. Rejected by 9 votes against and 7 votes for.
- 2. To increase the number of players from 4 to 5. Approved unanimously.
