Apologies were received from Anthony Still and Mo Irvani.

Items proposed, seconded and agreed were as follows:-

The Accounts for 2019-2020 were approved. It was agreed that the surplus funds be added to the prize fund. David Hill and Alan Reed were re-elected and David Eyre was elected as Vice-President following Alfred Jolliffe's retirement.

Spectrum (Freedom-Leisure) have advised that the lineage will not be increased this season so it remains £11.07. It was agreed that the league fees should remain at £14.00 per player.

All the prizes and refunds for the previous season had been paid by bank transfer during the lockdown.

With 12 teams, the League to run three times round, starting 1 September 2021 and finishing on 25 May 2022, with no bowling on 22 and 29 December 20 for the Christmas holidays. There will be 5 Fun Nights on 27 October 2021 and 16 February 2022 for Half-terms, 6 and 13 April 2022 for the Easter holidays and 1 June 2022 for Half-term plus 12post-season Fun Nights from 8 June to 24 August 2022, inclusive.

This means that the next AGM can be held on 31 August 2022 allowing the following season to start on 7 September 2022.

There was one proposal for a change to the Constitution for consideration: -

1. To revert back to 7:00pm start time. As there was a fair amount of support to stay at 7:15pm this proposal was withdrawn.
